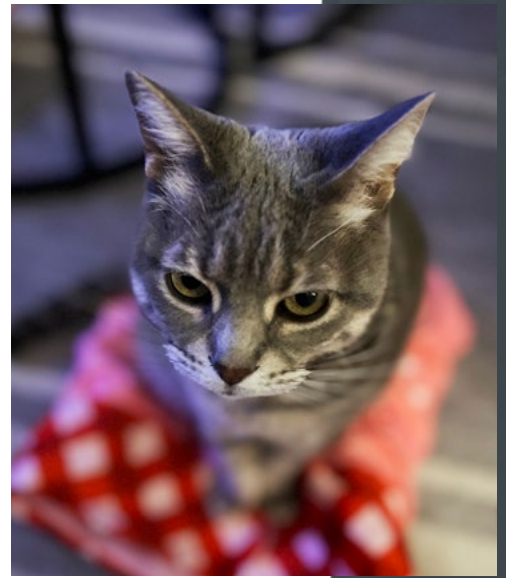
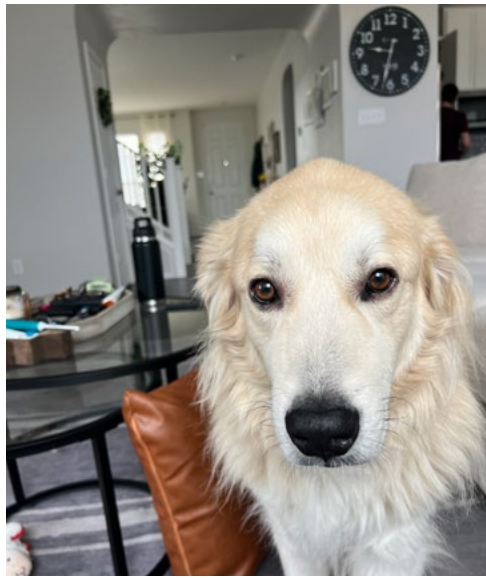

- I grew up in El Paso, we'd go to Juarez to get real Mexican cuisine for lunch.

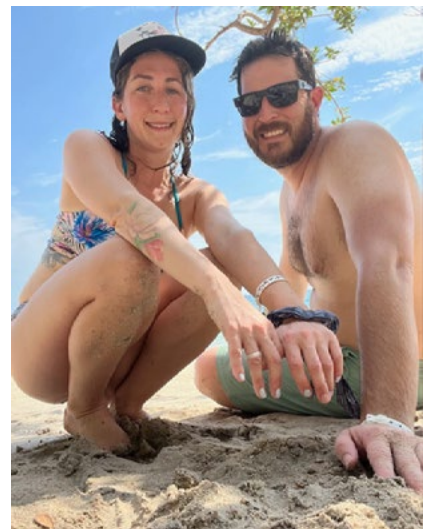




# our travels

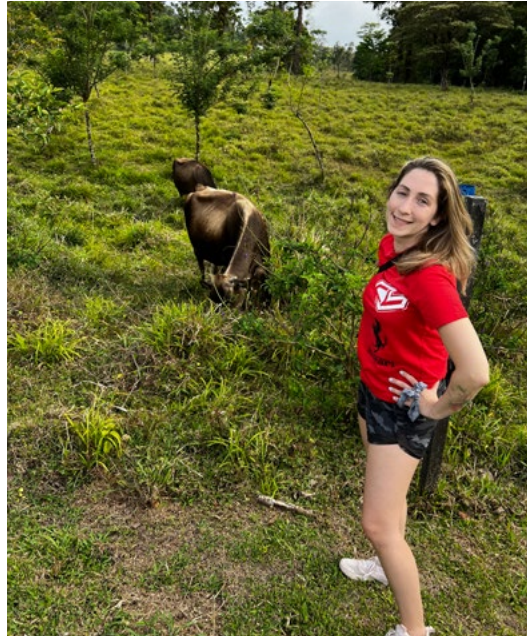


**We absolutely plan to continue traveling with our future child.**

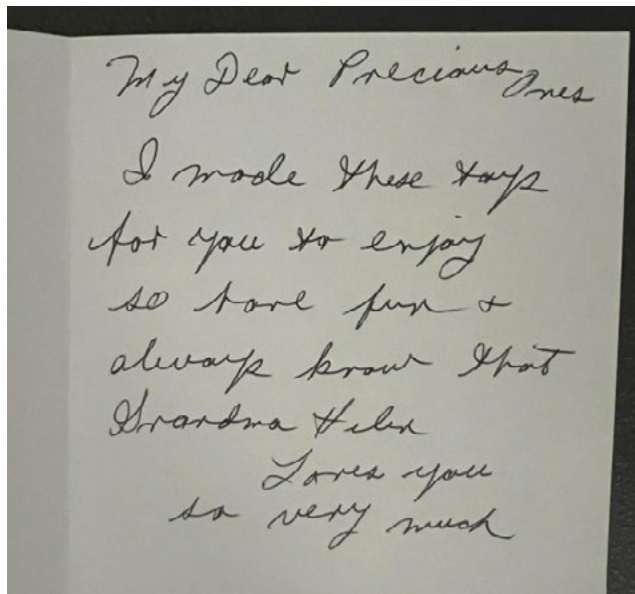
# Grandma Helen

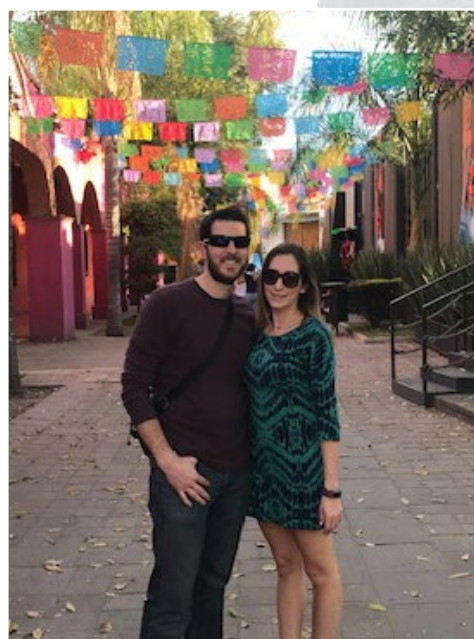
It reads: My dear precious ones: I made these toys for you to enjoy. So have fun and always know that Grandma Helen loves you so very much.
