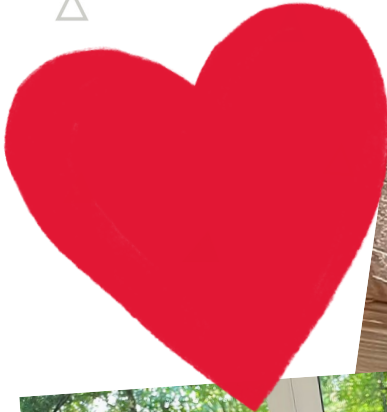




Dear Expectant Parents,

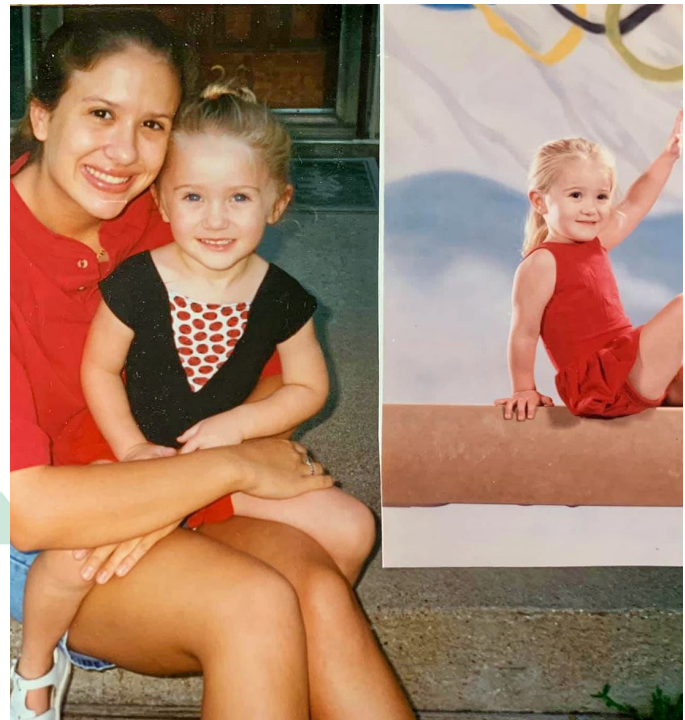
About Me

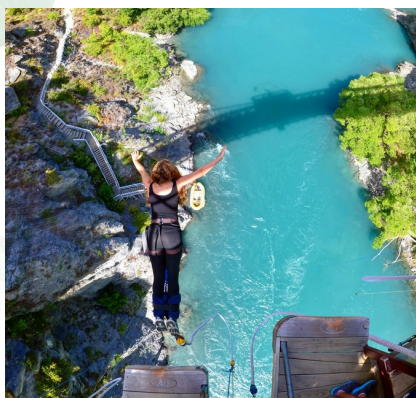

We had quite a few family pets growing up. I love dogs!



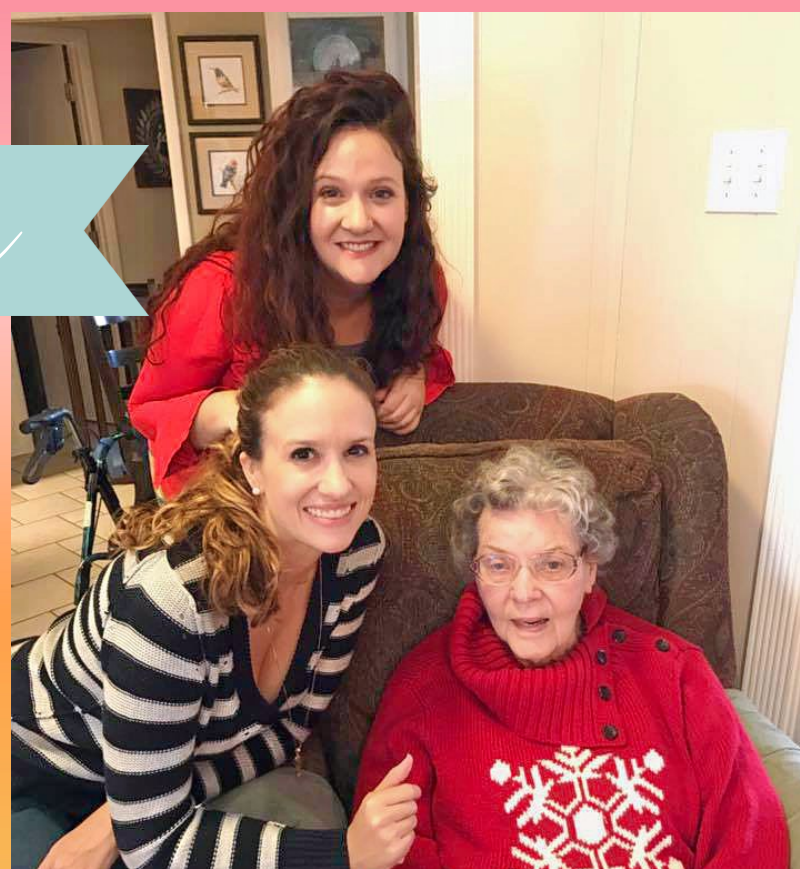

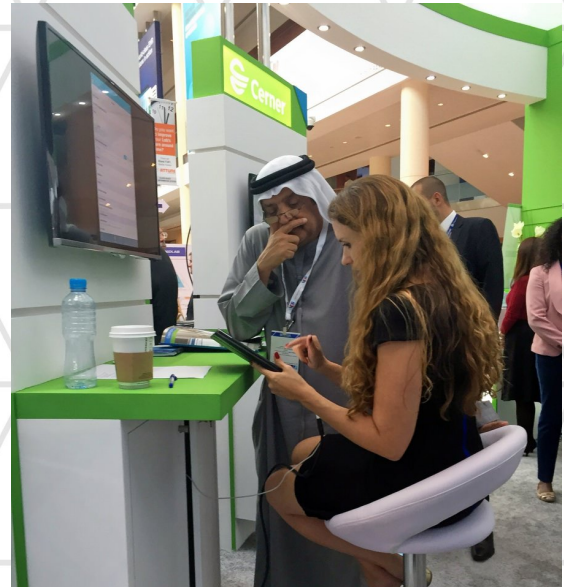

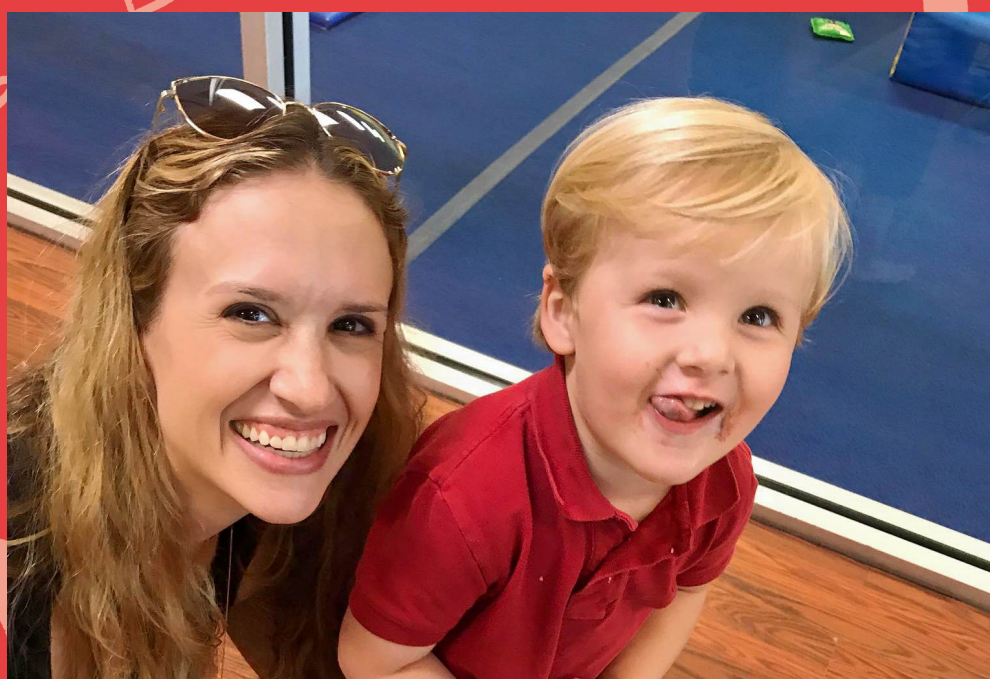
I live in a beautiful Dallas neighborhood with tree-lined streets and multiple parks in walking distance. Lush gardens surround the front and back of my home.
